## **Local Officials to Arm Themselves Against the Flu**

Mayor Barrett to join City of Milwaukee Health Department in reminding Milwaukee residents to protect themselves and their families against the flu

MILWAUKEE - On Tuesday, Oct. 14, Mayor Tom Barrett and Commissioner of Health Beyan K. Baker will join children and families at Neighborhood House of Milwaukee to share a message that getting vaccinated against the flu protects you, your family, and your co-workers.

Influenza (the flu) is among the most common contagious respiratory illness in the United States. Though common, it can be serious, leading to hospitalization and sometimes death. During the 2013-2014 flu season, more than 260 persons were hospitalized and two children died statewide.

The influenza vaccine is recommended for all individuals over 6 months of age, especially those at greatest risk for serious complications, including adults 65 and older, children younger than 5, and pregnant women.

A limited number of seasonal flu vaccine will be available to all ages on a first-come, first-served basis during the event.
