



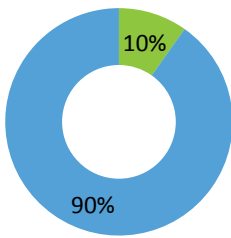
The City of Milwaukee Health Department conducted a survey in an effort to better understand what issues mattered the most to the Milwaukee community. A total of 3026 surveys were completed between July 15, 2016 and September 30, 2016.

**Top 5 issues that need to be addressed to improve the health and well-being of the Milwaukee community**

(% of survey respondents who selected the issue)

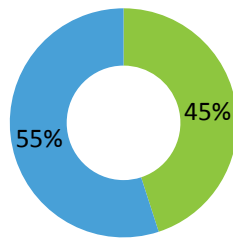
1. Crime and neighborhood safety – 42.8%
2. Access to affordable and healthy food – 39.9%
3. Jobs and income/wages – 33.8%
4. Education – 29.8%
5. Access to basic human needs – 27.8%

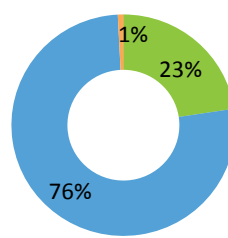

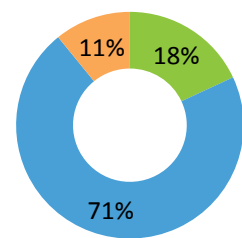

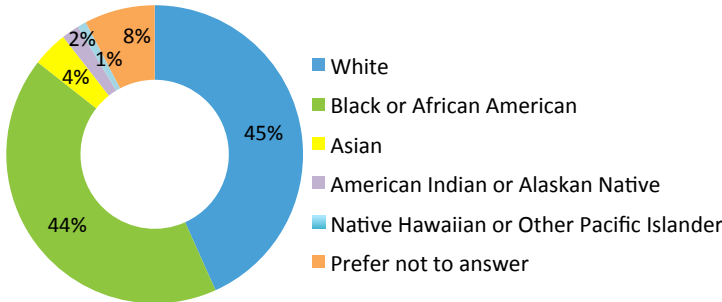

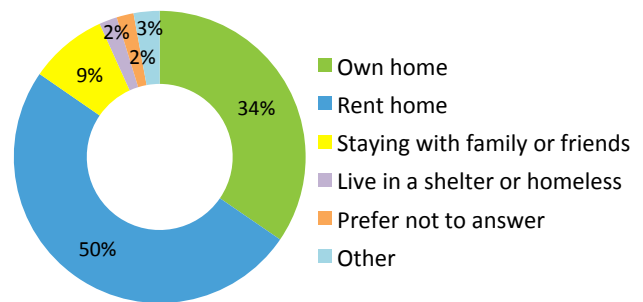

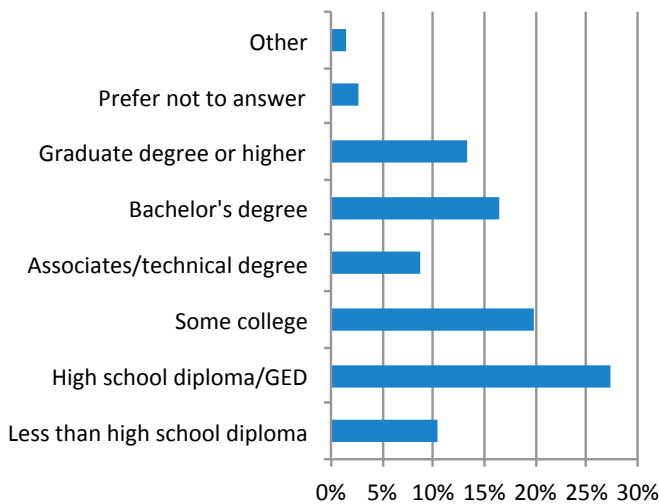

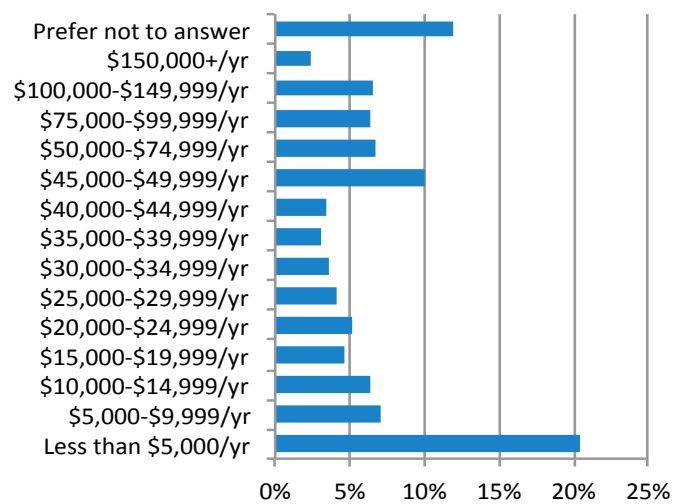

**Total annual household income before taxes**

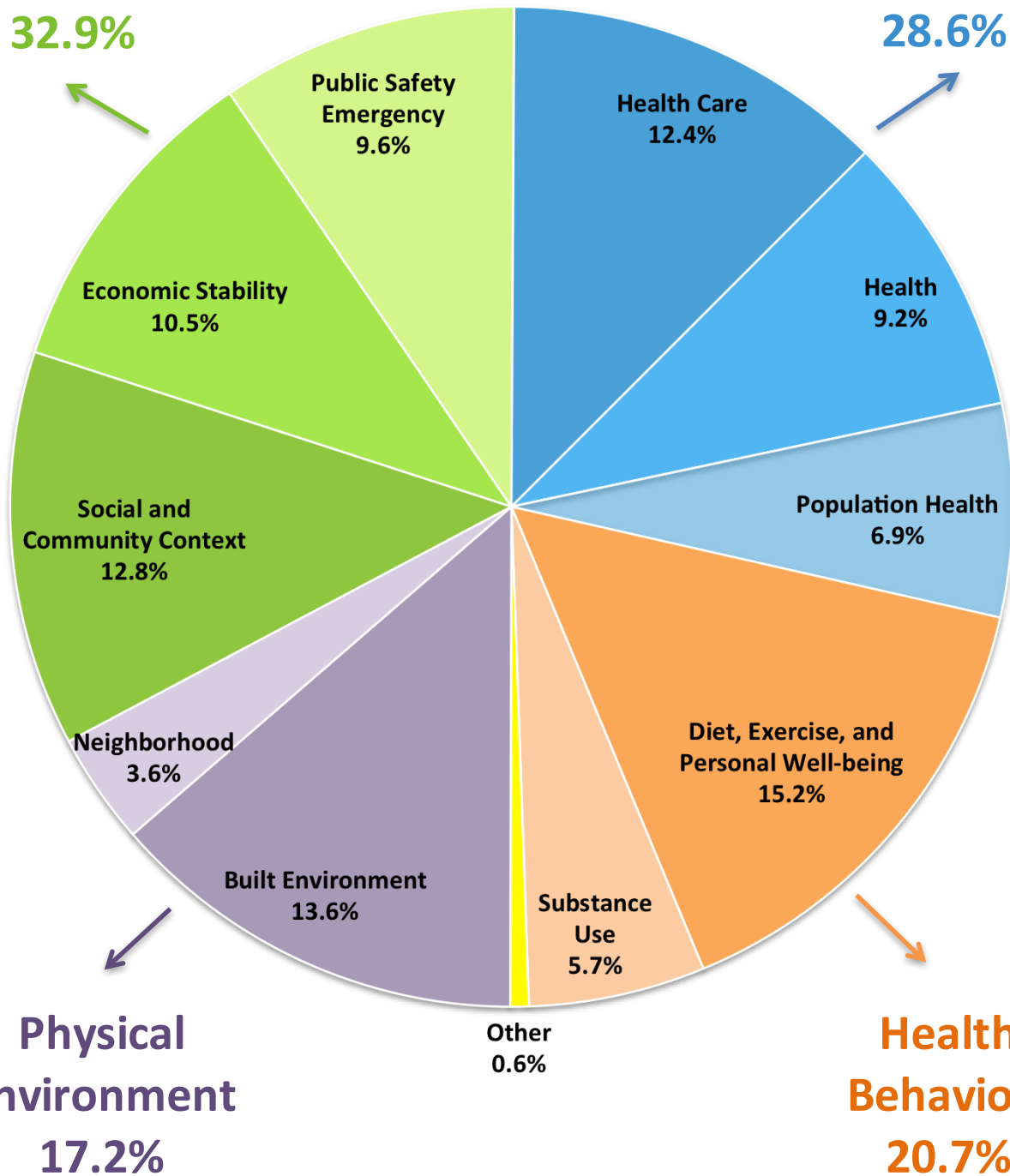

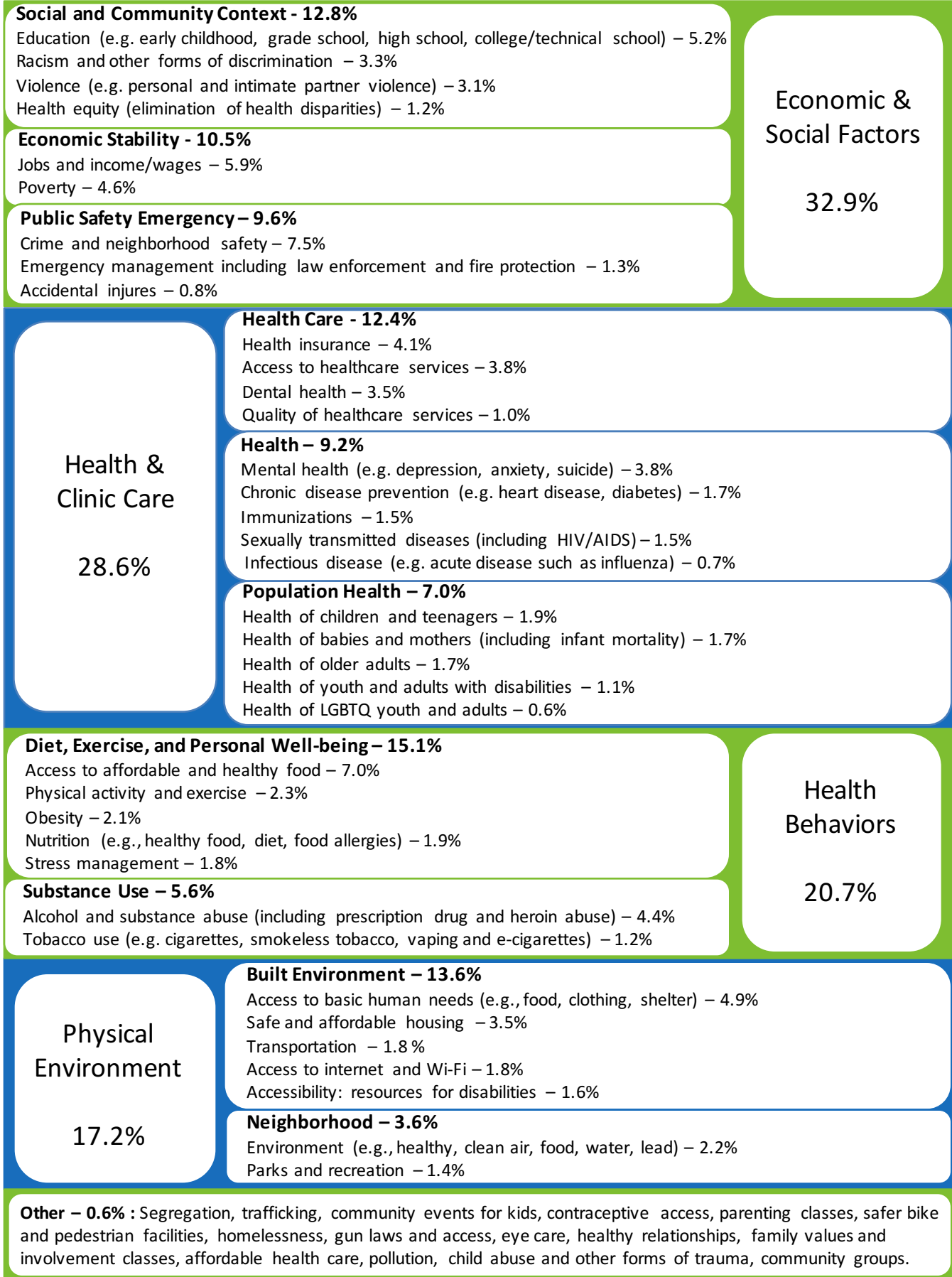

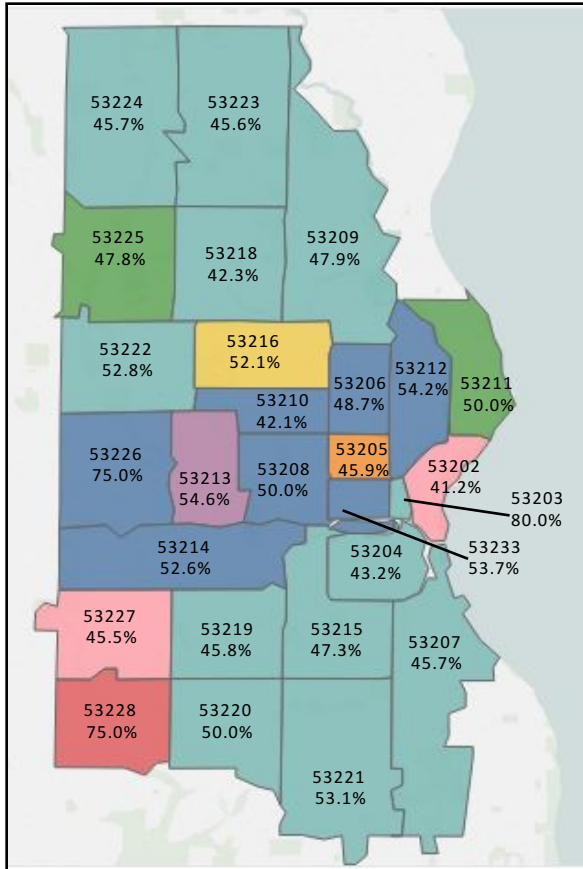

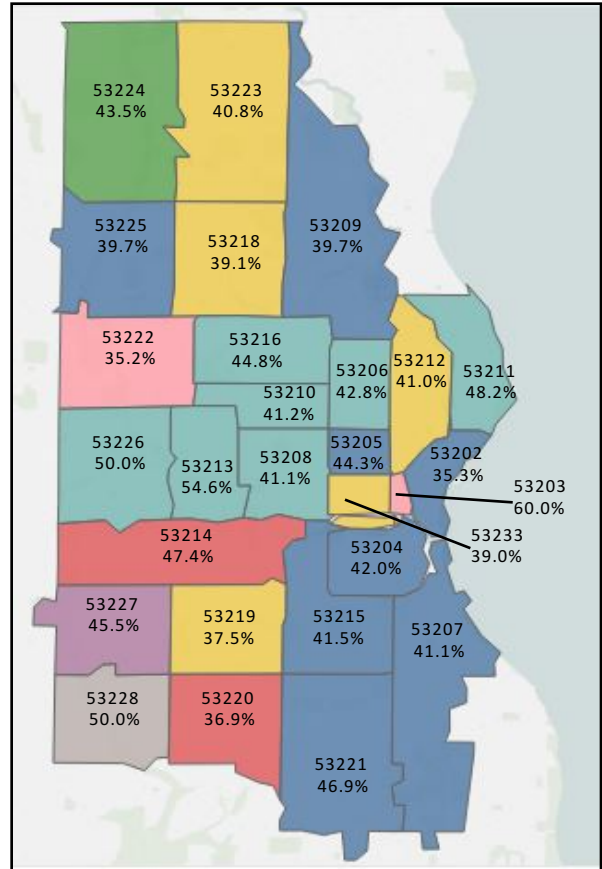

## First Priority by ZIP Code

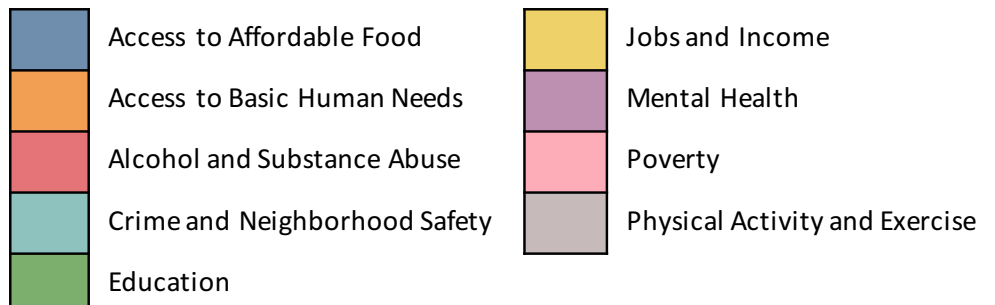


## Second Priority by ZIP Code
