January through December 2001

These are the year 2001 Milwaukee County reports of communicable diseases required to be reported by healthcare providers and laboratories. SurvNet is a component of a county-wide surveillance system that is funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention through Wisconsin Department of Health and Family Services and maintained and operated by the City of Milwaukee Health Department. These cases meet the Wisconsin case definitions for reportable diseases.
