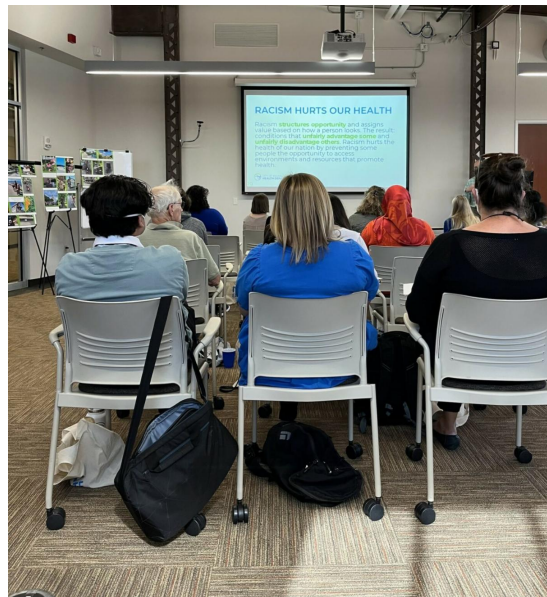
## Upcoming Events and Opportunities to Engage

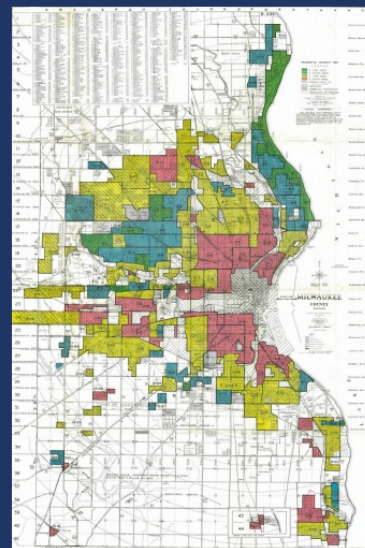
The City of Milwaukee Health Department's (MHD) 2022 Community Health Assessment (CHA) is now available.

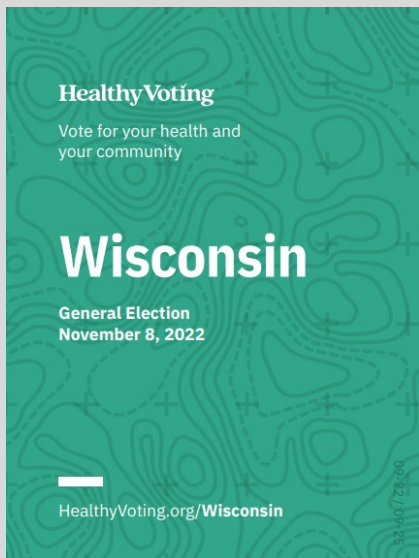
