Two special teams call Battalion 2 home; the Heavy Urban Rescue Team (HURT) and Tactical EMS Team (TEMS). Combined, the apparatus assigned to Battalion 2 responded to 33,338 calls for service in 2025. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Chief was the busiest Chief Officer in the city by responding to 1,531 total calls with 422 fires. Engine 24 was the second busiest Engine Company citywide, responding to an overwhelming 5,581 calls for service. Rescue 2 responded to more fires than any other company in Milwaukee in 2025 with 531 fire calls.

Battalion 2 covers a very busy area that consists of a mix of residential structures and commercial properties. The Capitol Drive and Fond du Lac Avenue corridors have a variety of complex properties that offer significant challenges to firefighting. The members of Battalion 2 prepare for such varied emergencies by dedicating significant hours to training and pre-fire planning. Through company- and battalion-based training the members of Battalion 2 logged several thousand training hours in 2025. Additionally, the Heavy Urban Rescue Team and TEMS Team engage in team-wide training monthly to sharpen their skill sets in highly technical special rescue and tactical EMS disciplines.
