

2025 MFD TRAINING ACADEMY

- Facilitated 322,417 training hours for sworn personnel.
- Delivered 72 company-based trainings for field and administrative personnel, covering fire, EMS, legal, social, and wellness topics.
- Completed two 16-week recruit training programs with a total of 81 recruits graduating, of which 20 of those entered the field with paramedic licensure.
- While working toward their firefighting and emergency medical technician certifications, and paramedic licensure, cadets worked with Habitat for Humanity learning building construction and framing two houses. They also worked with Big Brothers Big Sisters of America, and the American Red Cross Sound the Alarm.
- Conducted State of Wisconsin certified courses for the MFD Professional Development Program to include Driver/Operator, Fire Officer 1, Fire Officer 2, and Emergency Services Instructor.
- Hosted two Firefighter-For-a-Day events to staff from City departments, healthcare agencies, and other partners with the MFD to provide advanced insight into the life of a firefighter.
