

## 2021 SHARED SERVICES HIGHLIGHTS

Multi-department training collaboration took place at locations such as Milwaukee's International Airport Fuel Tank Farm, and Milwaukee's eight-acre Solar Panel Farm adjacent to the 128<sup>th</sup> Air Refueling Wing.

On April 21, the municipalities of Cudahy, Franklin, Greendale, and Hales Corners joined the initiative. **All municipalities in Milwaukee County are now active participants in the Shared Services Program.**

The following are some significant assists:

- On April 1, the MFD responded to the Village of Brown Deer for a 2<sup>nd</sup> alarm in a large two-story apartment building at 9500 North Green Bay Road.
- On April 2, the MFD and several of its Shared Services partners responded to the Village of Menomonee Falls to fight a 230-acre marsh fire. The 5<sup>th</sup> alarm with five inter-divisional task forces and strike teams resulted in 74 agencies responding to this fire.
- On June 4, the MFD responded to a fast-moving 2<sup>nd</sup> alarm fire in the Village of Hales Corners that destroyed a two-story apartment building at 10345 West Plum Tree Court.
- On November 28, the MFD responded to a 2<sup>nd</sup> alarm in a two-story apartment building in the City of Oak Creek at 7980 South Wildwood Court.
- On December 26, the MFD responded to the Village of River Hills for a 2<sup>nd</sup> alarm fire in a large farmhouse at 1050 West Bradley Road.

**In order to provide the closest available emergency resources in 2021, the MFD responded to 909 calls to neighboring Shared Services communities, and received assistance into the City of Milwaukee 1,272 times.**
