Incidents of Misconduct Second Quarter of 2026

The Chief of Police reviewed the following incidents of misconduct during the Second Quarter of 2026. These incidents resulted in the listed disciplinary action:

1. A Police Officer and their partner failed to show due regard in a vehicle pursuit causing a collision.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to exercise due regard when operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity **[5-day suspension without pay]**.
2. A Police Officer failed to intervene while their partner failed to show due regard during a vehicle pursuit causing a collision.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to intervene when observing driver not showing due regard while operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity **[2-day suspension without pay]**.
3. A Police Officer lost department issued equipment while on duty and delayed reporting the incident.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to safeguard Department issued equipment **[1-day suspension without pay]**.
 - b. This is the member's first violation for failing to immediately notify a supervisor of the loss of Department property **[Letter Of Written Reprimand]**.
4. A Police Officer and their partner failed to show due regard while responding to a vehicle pursuit causing a collision.
 - a. This is the member's second violation for failing to exercise due regard when operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity **[5-day suspension without pay]**.
5. A Police Officer and their partner failed to complete a thorough investigation and file proper reports.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to conduct a complete investigation and file reports in a prompt and thorough manner **[Letter Of Written Reprimand]**.

6. A Police Officer with an assigned recruit officer failed to exercise restraint and display courtesy and professionalism to an arrestee.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to exercise restraint **[2-day suspension without pay]**.
 - b. This is the member's first violation for failing to treat the public with courtesy and professionalism **[2-day suspension without pay and Remedial Training in Professional Communications]**.
 - c. This is the member's first violation for failing to set an example **[1-day suspension without pay and Removal from the FTO Program]**.
7. A Police Officer failed to show due regard while responding to assist other officers on a call, causing a collision.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to exercise due regard when operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity **[3-day suspension without pay]**.
8. A Police Officer and another officer failed to complete a thorough investigation, make a mandatory arrest and file proper reports.
 - a. This is the member's second violation for failing to conduct a complete investigation and file reports in a prompt and thorough manner **[3-day suspension without pay and Remedial Training]**.
 - b. This is the member's first violation for failing to make a mandatory arrest for a Domestic Violence offense **[2 day suspension without pay]**.
9. A Police Officer and another officer failed to complete a thorough investigation, make a mandatory arrest and file proper reports.
 - a. This is the member's second violation for failing to conduct a complete investigation and file reports in a prompt and thorough manner **[3-day suspension without pay and Remedial Training]**.
 - b. This is the member's first violation for failing to make a mandatory arrest for a Domestic Violence offense **[2-day suspension without pay]**.
10. A Police Officer made profane and unprofessional comments to

another individual.

- a. This is the member's second violation for behaving in such a manner that discredit could be brought upon the Department **[5-day suspension without pay]**.

11. A Police Officer failed to properly secure a prisoner that was able to escape.

- a. This is the member's first violation for failing to handcuff a prisoner behind their back and take all necessary precautions to prevent escape **[Letter Of Written Reprimand]**.

12. A Police Officer failed to intervene while their partner failed to show due regard during a vehicle pursuit causing a collision.

- a. This is the member's second violation for failing to intervene when observing driver not showing due regard while operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity **[2-day suspension without pay]**.

13. An off-duty Police Officer was arrested for a Domestic disturbance.

- a. This is the member's first violation for behaving in such a manner that discredit could be brought upon the Department **[3-day suspension without pay]**.

14. An off-duty Police Officer sent inappropriate messages to a member of the public.

- a. This is the member's first violation for behaving in such a way that discredit could be brought upon the Department **[Letter Of Written Reprimand]**.

15. A Detective failed to file proper reports.

- a. This is the member's first violation for failing to prepare reports in a prompt and thorough manner **[3-day suspension without pay]**.

16. A Police Officer failed to intervene while their partner failed to show due regard during a vehicle pursuit.

- a. This is the member's third violation for failing to intervene when observing driver not showing due regard while operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity **[2-day**

suspension without pay].

17. A Police Officer and their partner failed to show due regard in a vehicle pursuit causing a collision.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to exercise due regard when operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity **[3-day suspension without pay].**
18. A Detective failed to treat another member with courtesy and professionalism.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to treat another member with courtesy and professionalism **[Letter Of Written Reprimand].**
19. A Detective engaged in sexually harassing behavior and inappropriate conduct with another department member.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for engaging in verbal and physical sexual advances and behavior that created an offensive work environment **[10-day suspension without pay and Demotion to Police Officer]**.
 - b. This is the member's first violation for engaging in physical sexual harassment **[10-day suspension without pay and Demotion to Police Officer]**.
 - c. This is the member's first violation for engaging in inappropriate conduct **[5-day suspension without pay]**.
