Incidents of Misconduct Second Quarter of 2022

The Chief of Police reviewed the following incidents of misconduct during the Second Quarter of 2022. These incidents resulted in the listed discipline:

1. An off-duty Police Officer had department issued equipment stolen from their personal vehicle.
 - a. This is the member's first offense of failing to properly safeguard department equipment. **[Four day suspension without pay]**
2. A Police Officer failed to fully investigate a domestic violence complaint.
 - a. This is the member's second offense of failing fully investigate an incident. **[Five day suspension without pay and remedial training]**
3. A Police Officer and their partner failed to fully investigate a domestic violence complaint and arrest the suspect.
 - a. This is the member's first offense of failing to investigate a domestic violence incident. **[Five day suspension without pay]**
 - b. This is the member's first offense of failing to make a mandatory arrest for domestic violence. **[Five day suspension and remedial training]**
4. A Police Officer and their partner failed to fully investigate a domestic violence complaint and arrest the suspect.
 - a. This is the member's first offense of failing to investigate a domestic violence incident. **[Five day suspension without pay]**
 - b. This is the member's first offense of failing to make a mandatory arrest for domestic violence. **[Five day suspension and remedial training]**
5. A Police Officer was approved and attended training out of state after filling in false information on a form.
 - a. This is the member's first violation of behavior that could bring discredit to the department. **[Thirty day suspension without**

- pay]**
- b. This is the member's first violation of failing to be forthright and candid on a form used for training. **[Thirty day suspension without pay]**
6. A Police Detective was approved and attended training out of state after filling in false information on a form.
- a. This is the member's first violation of behavior that could bring discredit to the department. **[Thirty day suspension without pay].**
 - b. This is the member's first violation of failing to be forthright and candid on a form used for training. **[Demotion].**
7. A Police Officer was involved in a collision with a bicyclist and failed to activate their body worn camera. The officer did not call for a supervisor to the scene to file a report.
- a. This is the member's first violation of failing to activate their BWC. **[Two day suspension without pay].**
 - b. This is the member's first violation of behavior that could bring discredit to the department. **[Three day suspension without pay].**
8. A Police Officer failed a random drug test.
- a. This is the member's first violation of Positive Random Test for Illegal Drug use. **[Dismissed from the Department]**
