Incidents of Misconduct Fourth Quarter of 2025

The Chief of Police reviewed the following incidents of misconduct during the Fourth Quarter of 2025. These incidents resulted in the listed discipline:

1. An off-duty Police Officer was arrested for a Domestic Violence but was not charged.
 - a. This is the member's first violation of behaving in a manner that a reasonable person would expect that discredit could be brought upon the department [**5-day suspension without pay**].
2. An off-duty Police Officer was charged with Endangering Safety By Use Of Dangerous Weapon that made news stories.
 - a. This is the member's first violation of failing to obey state laws [**Discharged from the Department**].
 - b. This is the member's first violation of behaving in a manner that a reasonable person would expect that discredit could be brought upon the department [**Discharged from the Department**].
3. A Police Officer crashed while operating on emergency.
 - a. . This is the member's first violation for failing to exercise due regard while operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity [**1-day suspension without pay and Re-Training in Emergency Vehicle Operations**].
4. A Police Officer failed to stop for a red traffic signal and collided with another vehicle.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to operate a department vehicle in a safe manner [**4-day suspension without pay**].
5. An off-duty Police Officer was unprofessional towards officers that responded to the member's residence for an incident.
 - a. This is the member's first violation of failing to treat Department members with courtesy and professionalism [**4-day suspension without pay**].

6. A Police Officer crashed during a vehicle pursuit.
 - a. This is the member's first violation of failing to exercise due regard while operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity [**4-day suspension without pay**].

7. A Police Officer and their partner failed to exercise due regard while responding to assist another officer and were involved in a multicar collision.
 - a. This is the member's first violation for failing to exercise due regard while operating a department vehicle in an emergency capacity [**4-day suspension without pay and Re-Training in Emergency Vehicle Operations**].

8. A Police Officer failed to conduct a thorough investigation or file reports.
 - a. This is the member's first violation of failing to conduct a thorough investigation and prepare reports in a prompt, thorough, impartial and careful manner as to ensure accountability and responsibility in accordance with the law [**5-day suspension without pay and Remedial training**].

9. A Police Lieutenant pyramided roll call with other compensation, failed to report to duty at the designated time, did not accurately reflect time actually worked or and failed to set an example.
 - a. This is the member's first violation of pyramiding roll call with other overtime performed [**Demotion to the rank of Police Officer**].
 - b. This is the member's first violation of failing to report for duty at the time designated by supervisors [**Demotion to the rank of Police Officer**].
 - c. This is the member's first violation of failing to be forthright and candid, in writing, relative to an administrative report [**Demotion to the rank of Police Officer**].
 - d. This is the member's first violation of failing to set an example [**Demotion to the rank of Police Officer**].
