

Paying Your Property Tax Bill at the Bank

You can pay your tax bill in full, or make a monthly installment payment, at any of the twelve, full service US Bank branches within the City of Milwaukee. You can make your tax payment at one of these US Bank branches either by cash or check. You need to have your entire tax bill, **with the scanable return remittance coupon attached**, with you when making your tax payment at the bank branch. **Tax payment checks should be made payable to the City of Milwaukee.** The bank teller will stamp a payment acknowledgement on the top part of your tax bill and return it to you. The City Treasurer's Office will mail you a combined property tax payment receipt within five working days of payment processing. **US Bank will not issue tax refunds, nor will it accept payments on prior year delinquent tax accounts.** If your property tax escrow check exceeds the amount due and you make your payment at a US Bank branch, a refund will be mailed to you with a tax receipt within ten calendar days of payment processing. Monthly installment payments are acknowledged on the following month's billing statement.
