


# HOW TO DOWNLOAD YOUR TAX BILLS & RECEIPTS

If you would like to download and/or print copies of your City of Milwaukee property tax bills or receipts, follow the process below. *(This tutorial is written from the perspective of a desktop computer. While the steps on mobile are identical, the layout differs.)*

1. Navigate to our website:  
city.milwaukee.gov/treasurer.
2. Scroll down to our “Quick Links” section and select “Resident Access/Pay Online.” Our payment portal is also the database for our property tax records.
3. On the next screen, select “Real Estate Tax.”
4. Click on “Search public records” on the right.

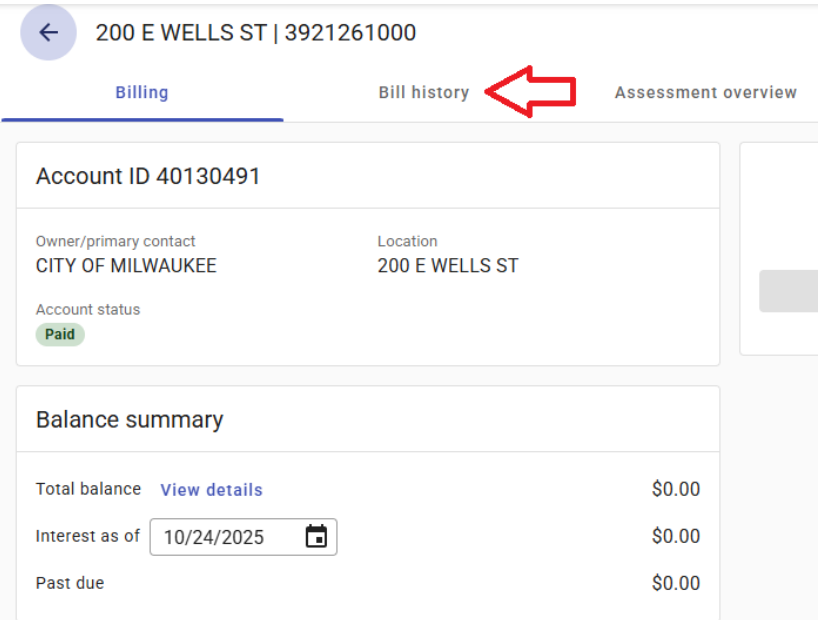

5. On the next screen, choose a field to search by. Enter your information exactly as it appears on the bill.
6. Click “Search.”
7. The property owner name & tax key should appear below. Click on the search result.
8. You will now see an account overview. Click on “Bill History.”
9. After a moment, the bill history will load, displaying the last 10 years of property tax information. (cont. opposite pg)

## HOW TO DOWNLOAD YOUR TAX BILLS & RECEIPTS









10. Click the paperclip  icon next to the desired levy year. This will bring up a list of bills and receipts generated for that year.

11. You will see a list of documents in this new window. Clicking one will load the associated PDF.

a. The “Combined Tax Bill” is the original bill generated and sent out in December. It details each individual charge that contributes to the tax bill. It will always be the bottom most document.

b. The “PAID IN FULL” bill is your receipt for payment of taxes. (Note: The system automatically generates receipts and bills only for the current year’s levy.)

12. Once the PDF is loaded, you can print directly from the window displayed and/or save the document for later use.
