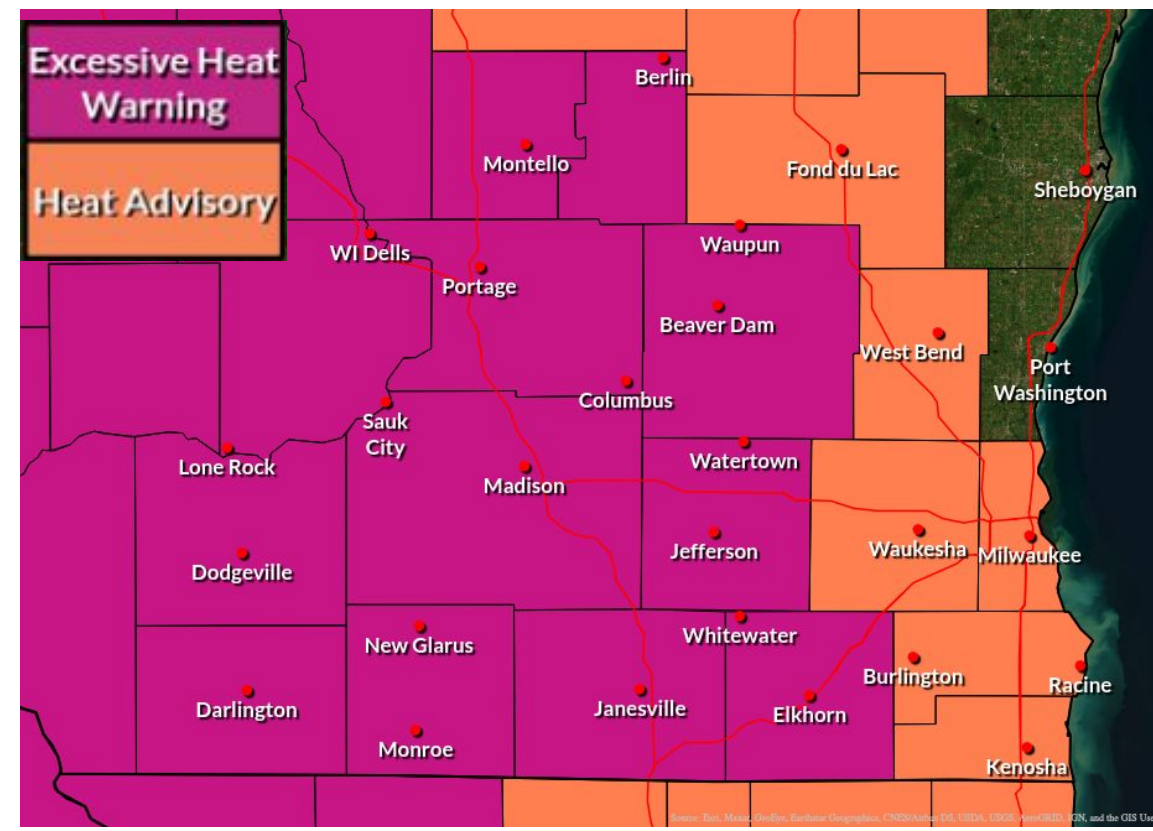


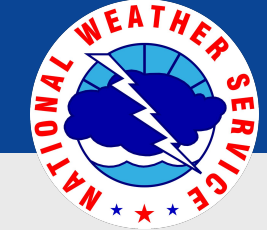
Maximum Heat Index Forecast (°F)

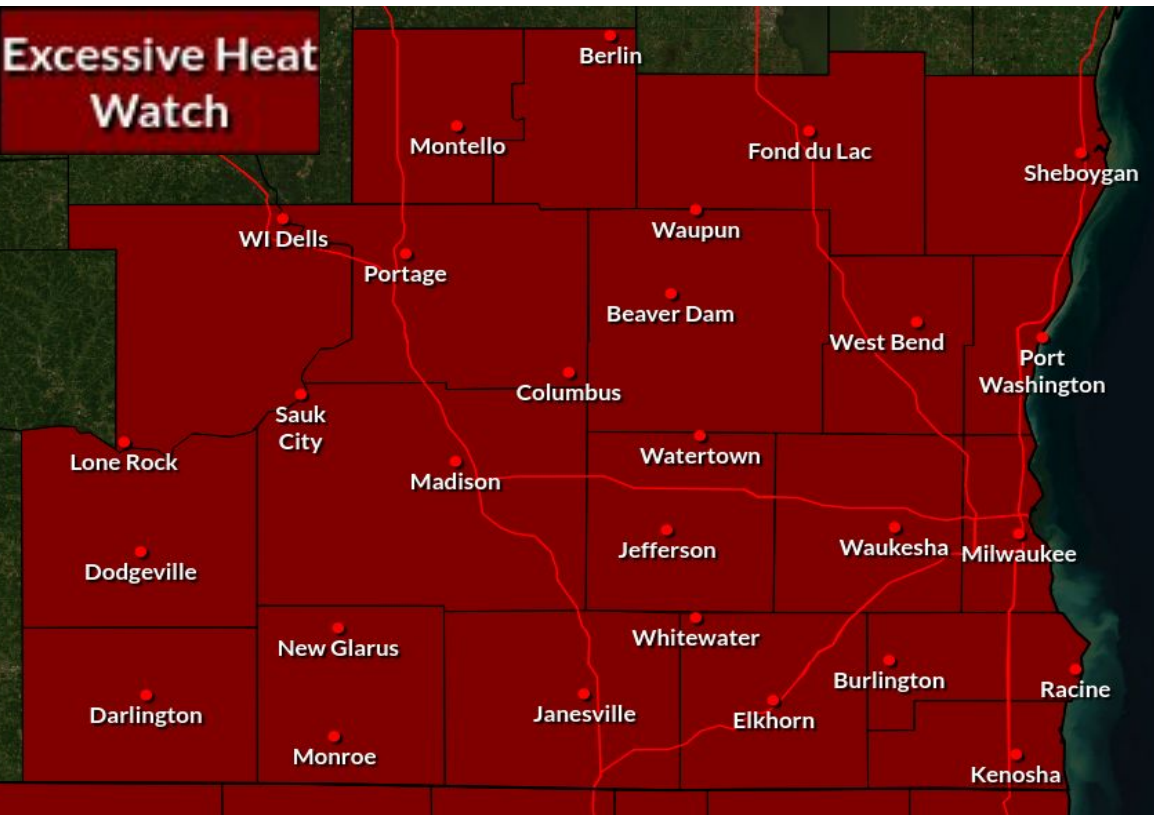


Maximum Heat Index Forecast (°F)

Key Points

- An Excessive Heat Watch is in effect for all of southern Wisconsin on Tuesday from 1 PM - 8 PM CDT, with widespread heat indices of 100-110° F expected.
- Some uncertainty with Tuesday heat with morning and afternoon clouds/rain from potential storms, **possibly lowering the higher end heat potential.**

Conditional Severe Weather Risk

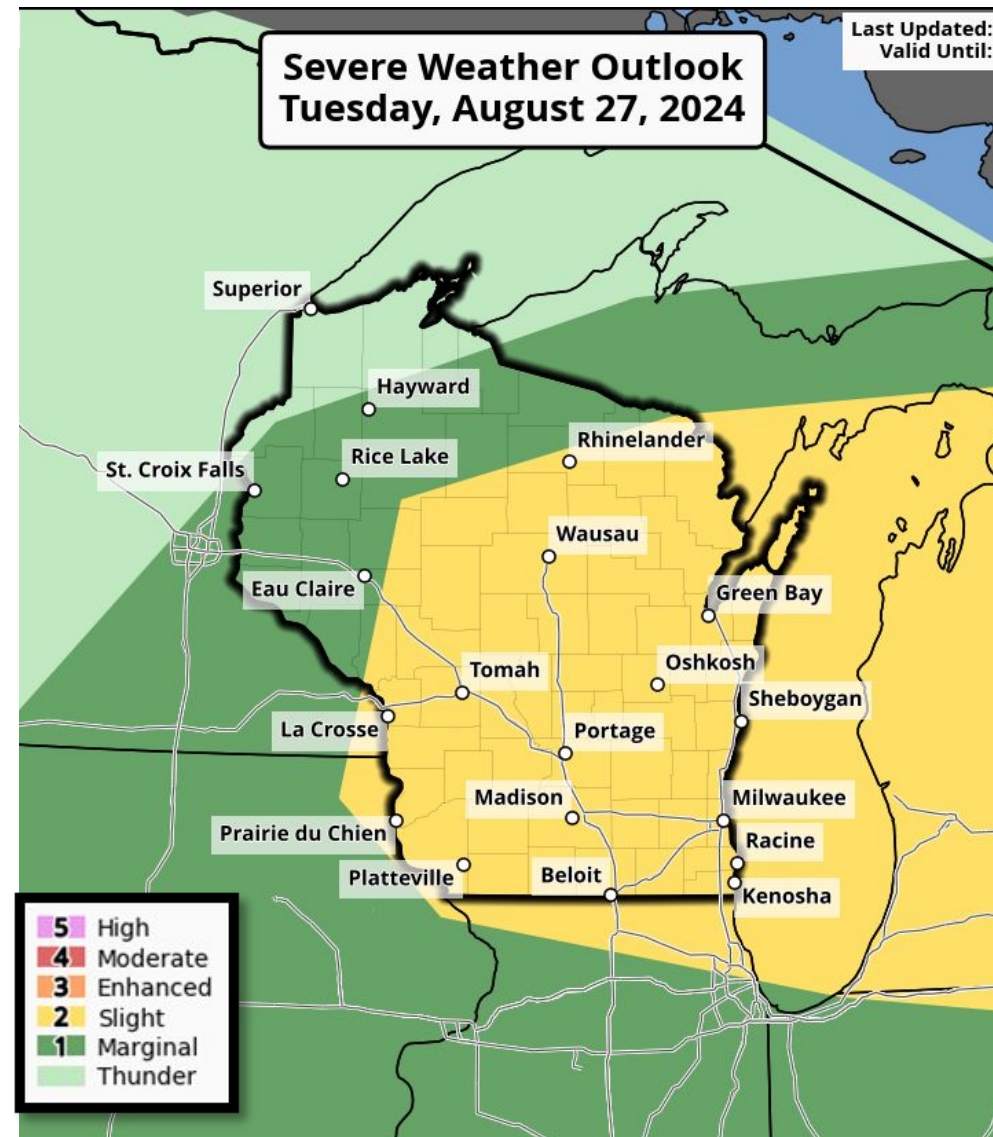
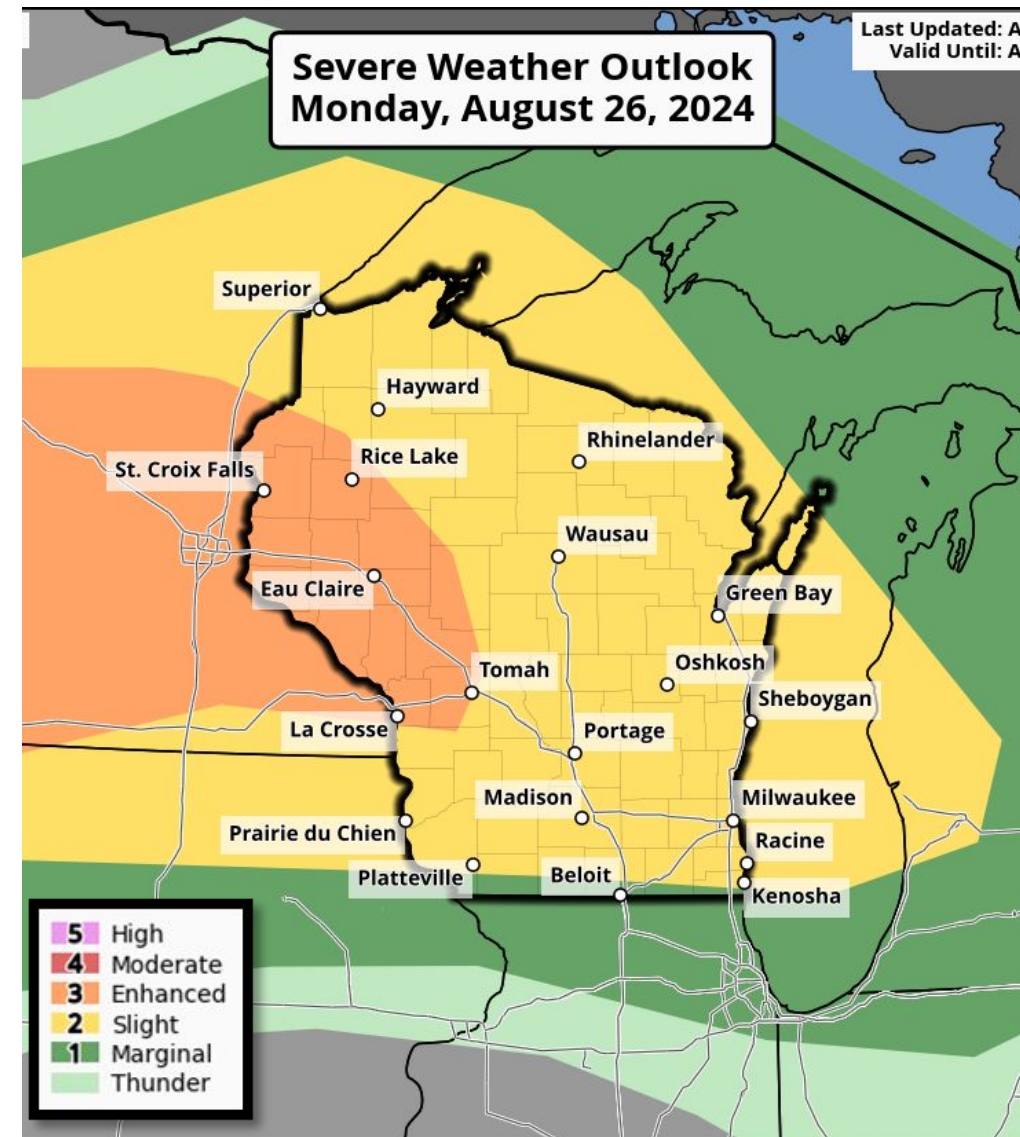
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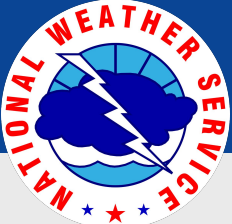
Considerable Uncertainty as to Whether Storms Will Form

Details

- A line of severe storms may approach the region very early Tuesday morning.
- IF storms move this far south, strong winds are expected.
- Additional storms may develop Tuesday afternoon and evening.
- Very strong winds and large hail can be expected, IF storms are able to form.

Note: A cap of warm air may ultimately limit storm coverage one or both days.
