Dear Kagel Families and Staff,

We are pleased to share that the City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) has completed a clearance check at Kagel School, and the school has passed. This means that lead dust levels meet safety standards, and no further remediation is required at this time.

Moving forward, Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) will continue enhanced cleaning and maintenance protocols throughout the building to ensure the school remains safe for students and staff. MHD will remain engaged to support MPS in upholding safety standards. MPS will also work to ensure students and staff only drink from filtered water stations.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we worked with MPS to ensure all safety protocols were followed. The health and safety of students and staff remain our top priority, and we will continue to support MPS in maintaining a safe learning environment.
