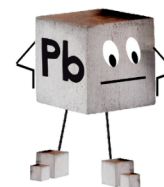
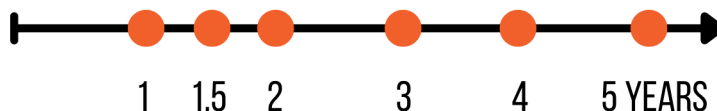

GET A FINGER-POKE TEST AT THESE AGES:



PREVENTATIVE MEASURES

- Wet dust and mop your home twice a week
- Wash your child's hands with soap often, and always before meals
- Feed your child with foods rich in Iron, Vitamin C, and Calcium
- Cover or block lead hazards like chipping paint and keep children away
- Run your faucet on cold for 3 minutes before using, or drink filtered water
