Setting out—Easy as 1...2...3!

On your **guaranteed collection day** for garbage or recycling

- Have cart(s) to curb/alley by 7 AM
- Return cart(s) to storage by 10 PM
- Ensure snow is removed from carts and that there is a safe and open path for crews

Guaranteed Collection Days

Garbage collection is guaranteed all year round.

Recycling collection is guaranteed from spring – fall.*

In the winter, crews will collect your recycling cart from wherever it is stored approximately every 20 work days.* You are NOT responsible for putting it at the curb or alley when your collection date is not guaranteed during the winter months. You ARE responsible for keeping your cart accessible, keeping a shoveled, clear path, and returning it to your storage area once it has been collected.

*A few recycling routes have alternate schedules and include year-round guaranteed collection or more frequent collection.

Carts

- You should have 1 garbage and 1 recycling cart.
- To get additional carts call 286.CITY or complete a service request online.
- Additional recycling carts are free. Each additional garbage cart is \$17 per quarter. This charge appears on your water bill.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

HHW collections are managed by Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District and include year-round drop-off sites and 1-day collections.

Curbside Collection

For City residents in single family homes, duplexes, and up to 4 unit apartments.

Garbage

Garbage is collected weekly year-round.

Yes! All garbage must be in bags. Do not place loose garbage in your cart. This helps keep your neighborhood clean!

- No!**
- Yard waste
 - Electronics
 - Appliances
 - Tires
 - Hazardous waste
 - Recyclable paper, bottles, or cans



Recycling

Recycling collection varies by route. Recycling saves money and natural resources and it is the law. Recyclables should be loose in the bin—no plastic bags! **Exception: Extra recyclables** can be placed next to the bin or can be taken to a Self Help Center.



- Yes!**
- Metal** cans (aluminum and steel), empty aerosol cans, pots and pans
 - Glass** food/beverage jars and bottles.
 - Carton** beverage containers
 - Paper** cardboard, cereal boxes, junk mail, phone books, newspapers, and magazines
 - Plastic** bottles, jugs, and tubs w/ numbers 1, 2, and 5

- No!**
- Plastic bags
 - Propane tanks
 - Needles
 - Styrofoam
 - Motor oil jugs

Bulky Items

1 cubic yard of large items (the size of recliner) can be put out with your regular garbage for free pick up.

Fees for over 1+ cubic yard apply unless it is your annual Clean and Green collection. Learn more online or call 286-CITY.



Leaves and Brush

Brush piles less than 2 cubic yards (the size of a sofa) can be collected at your home April—November. Call or go online to request a pickup.

All yard waste (including brush, leaves, grass, weeds, etc.) can be taken to a Self Help Center.
