

City of Milwaukee Drop Off Centers For Recycling and Safe Disposal

City of Milwaukee residents can recycle or safely dispose of a wide variety of items at both Drop Off Center locations. Upon arrival, one occupant must show identification indicating City of Milwaukee residency or property ownership. No contractors or individuals performing commercial services are allowed.

Restricted vehicles. Certain vehicles will not be allowed access to the Drop Off Centers. These include but are not limited to vehicles with any type of business or commercial name or logo; ladders or side-walls; dual rear-axles; loads that are not able to be inspected or safely contained or secured; and large trailers that cannot maneuver easily through the yard.

Household Hazardous Waste is collected by MMSD at **Lincoln Avenue** on ONLY Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays. MMSD.com for other locations.

***Construction and Demolition wastes.** \$20 for up to 8 cubic yards. \$40 for 8—16 cubic yards. Cash, credit, & debit cards accepted. 16 cubic yards max per trip. Includes roofing material, brick, stones, concrete, lumber, dry-wall, paneling, & other construction material. No commercial loads allowed.

****Electronics.** Computers and computer equipment; TV's, and printers. 3 TV Maximum. Residential only.

*****Household Recyclables.** Plastic containers #1, 2, 4, & 5; bulky #2 plastics (i.e. 5 gal buckets); aluminum cans, foil & pans; cartons; glass bottles & jars; metal pots & pans; steel cans & empty aerosol cans; newspaper, magazines, paperback & phone books, paperboard, junk mail.
