### Help the City of Milwaukee Identify Illegal Dumping Suspect

Illegal dumping in the city of Milwaukee is a punishable crime and will not be tolerated in our neighborhoods. Additionally, enforcement and cleanup activities are costly for taxpayers and result in neighborhoods looking unsightly.

Last week, surveillance cameras caught a suspect illegally dumping. If you see this person or know who he is (photos attached), please contact the City of Milwaukee at 286-CITY (2489).

**Address of illegal dumping:** behind garage at 2528 N. 18th Street

**Vehicle:** dark green, late model Ford F-150 extended cab pickup truck

**No license plate:** Temporary license in front window

**Report illegal dumping:**

If you see illegal dumping in progress, please do not confront the individual(s). Write down the details and get the description of the suspect(s), vehicle make and model, license plate, the items dumped, address/location, and the date and time of the incident. Call the Milwaukee Police Department’s non-emergency number (414) 933-4444 to report illegal dumping in progress.
