

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will the street be open to traffic during construction?

Construction will be completed in two stages. Vehicular and pedestrian access will be maintained during both stages of construction.

The City's Support for Business Liaison will be available throughout construction to assist business owners in addressing issues that may arise.

Will Abutting property owners be assessed?

Assessments will go out to property owners near the end of the design stage. Assessments to owners will include sidewalk and driveway approach replacement in front of their property. Construction work on the bridge structure and limited portion of the roadway impacted by the construction of the bridge are funded with 80% Federal/State aid and 20% Local (City of Milwaukee) fund. Any additional work on the roadway will be 100% locally funded. Assessments will be calculated for sidewalk and driveway replacement based on the City's share of the final cost.

What are the traffic volumes on this street?

S. Dana Court within the limits of this project (Hawley Rd and the Cul-de-sac) is dead end road and carries less than 500 vehicles per day.

Project Need

This bridge was originally constructed in 1926 and rehabbed with deck replacement in 1977. It has since deteriorated enough to become structurally deficient. The main area of deterioration for this structure is the concrete deck. The deck contains significant spalls with exposed rebar. The superstructure is corroding with instances of section loss. The railing is rusted. The asphalt pavement on the approach roadways is deteriorating and in bad condition.

When will construction start and finish on this project?

Construction for this project is scheduled to begin in mid-summer of 2021 and be completed by end of November, 2021.
