TRAFFIC ALERT

CLOSURE OF EAST LOCUST STREET AT NORTH HUMBOLDT BOULEVARD

AUGUST 10TH - SEPTEMBER 2ND

The eastern half of the intersection of E. Locust St. and N. Humboldt Blvd. will be closed to all modes of traffic from August 10th through September 2nd.

In order to reconstruct the intersection on the east half, the contractor has to remove the old street car tracks that run in the middle of both travel lanes. A closure has been planned because it will be more efficient, more cost effective and safer for the crew to remove and replace the intersection in one segment instead of multiple construction stages. We appreciate your patience during this project and advise the traveling public to allow for extra time while traveling to and from the neighborhood.

TRAFFIC

- North-southbound traffic on N. Humboldt Blvd. will be maintained.
- East Locust Street will be closed to thru traffic at N. Humboldt Blvd. For alternate east-west route, use E. North Ave. or E. Capitol Dr.
- Eastbound traffic on E. Locust St. will have to turn onto N. Humboldt Blvd. at the intersection.
- Westbound traffic on E. Locust St. will be restricted at N. Cambridge Ave. It is advised to take N. Oakland Ave. to E. North Ave. or E. Capitol Dr. for alternate route.
- Local access to adjacent properties on East Locust Street, east of N. Humboldt Blvd., will be maintained from N. Oakland Ave., east of the river. This includes the properties located on Humboldt Blvd. that access their driveways from the Locust Street alley. Short-term closures to this alley access are anticipated. Prior to any closures, a notice will be delivered to the affected properties.

PEDESTRIANS AND BICYCLISTS

- Pedestrians are advised to travel on the west side of N. Humboldt Blvd., and cross at E. Chambers St. or E. Hadley St. to access properties on the east side.
- Westbound route for bicyclists: Cross at the signalized light at E. Locust St. (near Locust Court building), travel through Gordon Park on Oak Leaf Trail, cross at E. Hadley St., head northbound on N. Humboldt Blvd. back to E. Locust St.
- Eastbound route for bicyclists on E. Locust St.: Travel southbound on N. Humboldt Blvd., cross at E. Hadley St., travel through Gordon Park on Oak Leaf Trail back to E. Locust St.
