Reconstruction of North 60<sup>th</sup> Street  
West Capitol Drive to West Hampton Avenue  
City of Milwaukee

Dear Property Owner:

The City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works (DPW) is inviting you to attend a public involvement meeting for the reconstruction of North 60<sup>th</sup> Street from West Capitol Drive to West Hampton Avenue (see project location map). The project is tentatively scheduled for reconstruction in 2020.

**The meeting will be held on Tuesday April 10, 2018 at Mt. Lebanon Evangelical Lutheran Church and School (Community Center) located on 4809 North 60<sup>th</sup> Street in Milwaukee 53218 between 6:00 PM and 8:00 PM. The meeting will be in an "Open House" format and no formal presentation will be made. Representatives from the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works will be available to answer questions.**

The proposed improvement consists of removing the deteriorated pavement and replacing it with new concrete pavement. All curb and gutter and driveway approaches will be replaced. The sidewalk will be replaced as necessary due to poor condition or grade differential. The improvement also consists of replacing storm sewer catch basins, improving current pedestrian accommodations to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, providing bicycle lanes, and improving the overall operations and safety of the roadway.

The proposed North 60<sup>th</sup> Street will have two driving lanes, one bike lane in each direction and a parking lane on the west side of the road between West Capitol Drive and North Fond du Lac Avenue. The proposed roadway design will eliminate the east side parking lane on North 60<sup>th</sup> Street between West Capitol Drive and West Fond du Lac Avenue. North 60<sup>th</sup> Street between West Fond du Lac Avenue and West Hampton Avenue will have two driving lanes, one bike lane and a parking lane in each direction.

North 60<sup>th</sup> Street within the project limits will remain open to two-way traffic with one lane in each direction during Stage I construction and during Stage II construction. Every effort will be made to maintain vehicular and pedestrian access to the abutting businesses during construction.

As required by the Section 106 process indicated in the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Facilities Development Manual for archeological/historical review, this notice is to also serve as formal notification for this project to persons with a concern for or knowledge about



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historic buildings, structures, and archeological sites located along the project. Such persons are encouraged to attend this meeting or provide comments to the City of Milwaukee. Information regarding any historic buildings, structures, and/or archeological sites will also be presented at the meeting.

It is very important that we receive public input on the proposed project as it will be directly impacting businesses and residents in the area. Input that is received at the Public Informational Meeting will assist in completing the proposed design and to answer any questions that the public may have.
