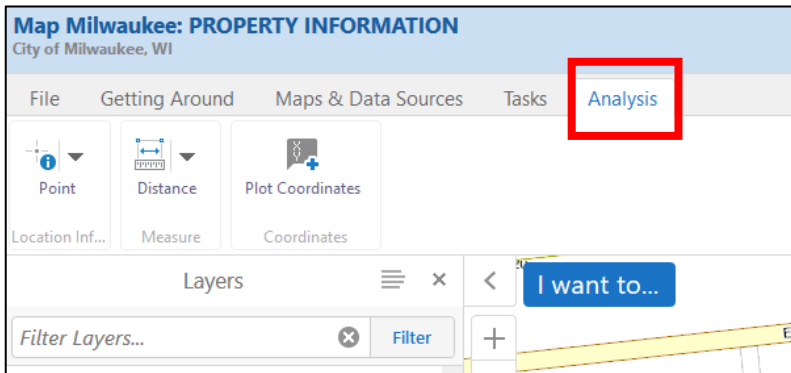
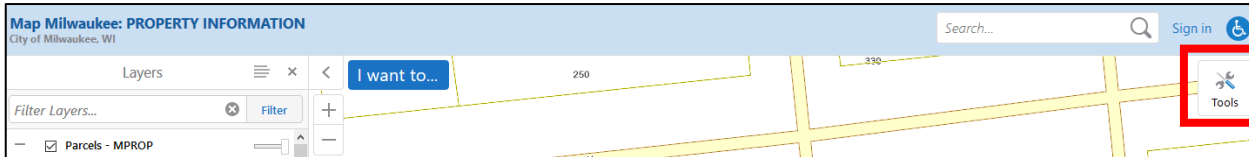


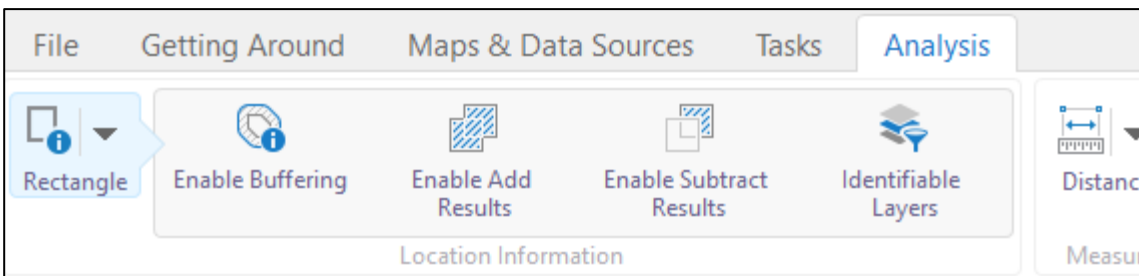
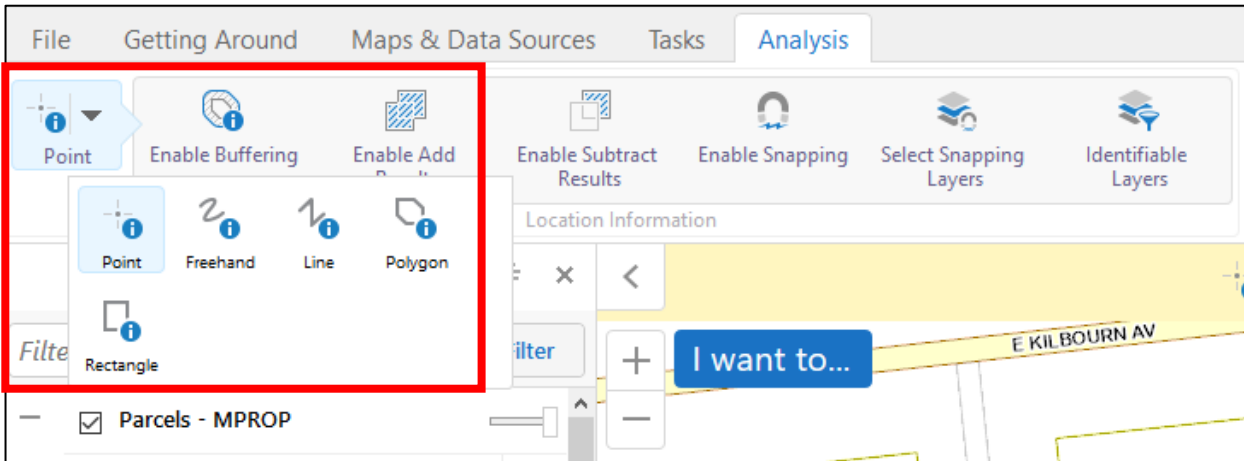
Map Milwaukee – Selecting and Exporting Data

If you need to get data from specific parts of Map Milwaukee, one of the maps services, or data you've uploaded, you can select the feature(s) and create various reports from it. You can also export the selected data as a shapefile or to a spreadsheet.

To start selecting features, zoom into the area of interest. Then, click on the **Tools** button and select the **Analysis** tab.

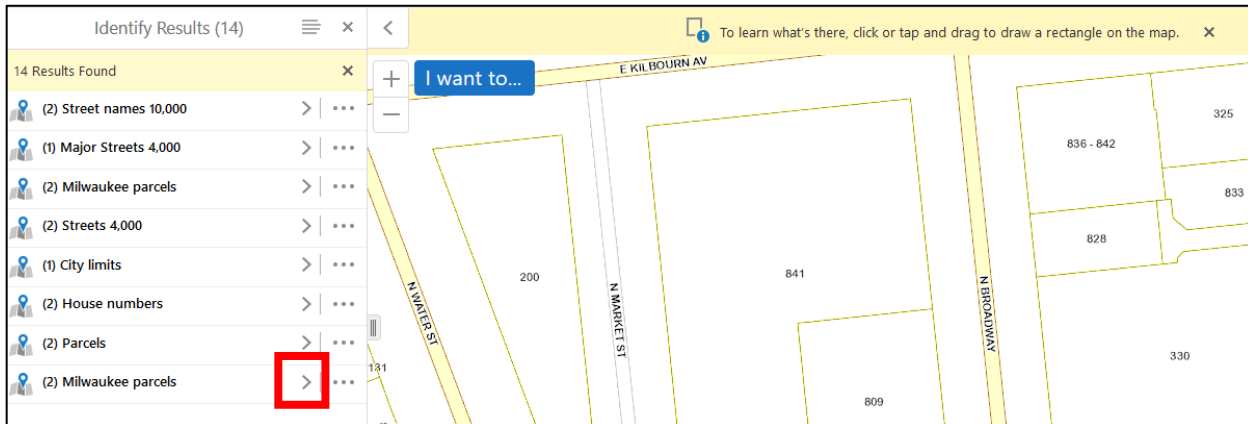


Click on the **Point** button. A new list of tools will appear. Selecting the down arrow on the **Point** button will show a list of options of how to select features within the map area. In this example, we will show Rectangle selecting.

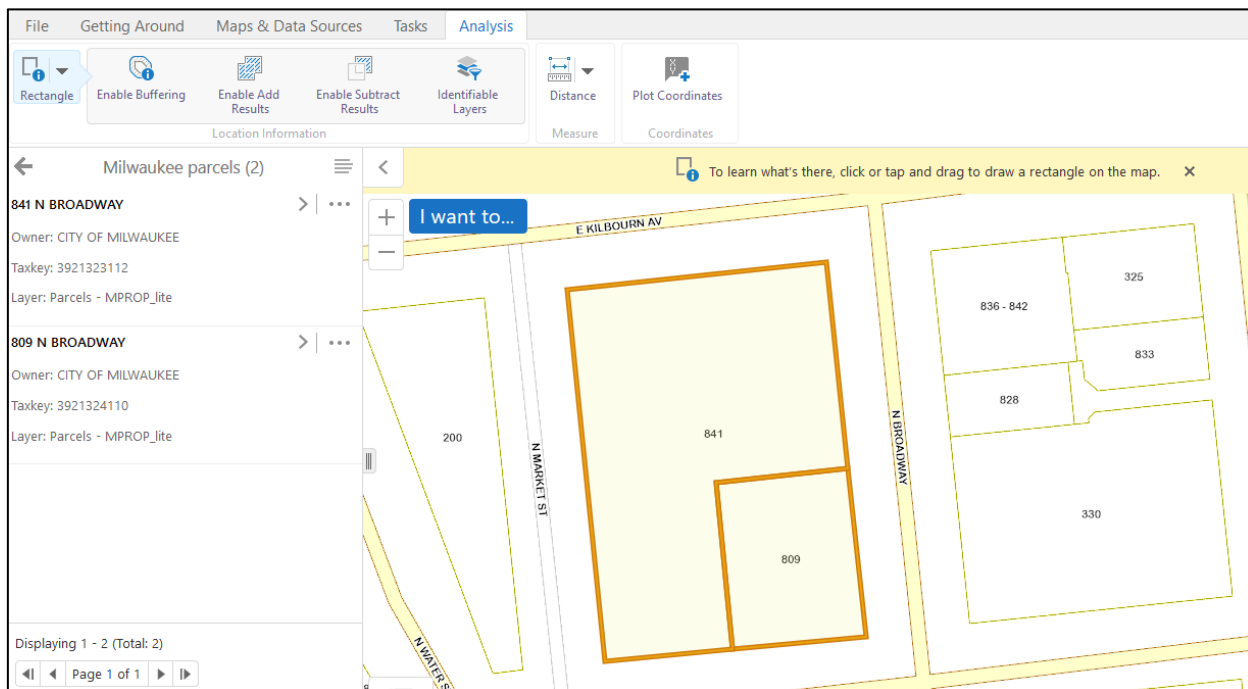


Map Milwaukee – Selecting and Exporting Data

Drag the mouse over an area on the map to select the features. The left pane will then show all the layers that were selected within the area the mouse dragged over. Select which layer you want to see additional details about by clicking the > button.

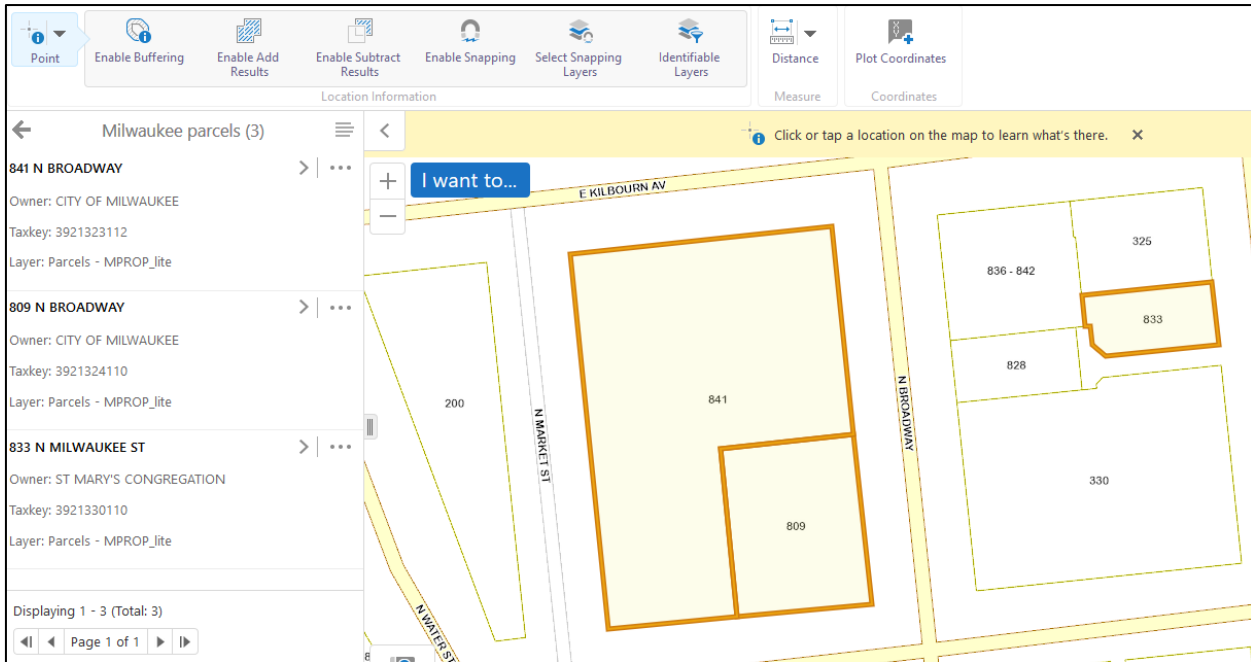


The features will be listed in the left pane and show as outlined by orange in the map view.

To add results from another area of the map view, click **Enable Add Results** in the **Analysis** tab and select the features in the map view.



To export the selected features, click on the stacked button on the top of the left pane. The options for export include CSV, XLSX, and Shapefile.
