### Acclaimed Venezuelan American Author/Attorney To Appear At City Hall

**Eva Golinger**, an acclaimed **author and international human rights attorney**, will be the special guest of **Ald. Joe Davis, Sr.** during a news conference and book discussion tomorrow at City Hall, 200 E. Wells St.

Ms. Golinger, of New York City, is best known for investigating and analyzing U.S. intervention in Venezuela in the past six years, and her best-selling books, “The Chavez Code” (2005) and “Bush vs. Chavez: Washington’s War on Venezuela” (2006) have garnered international attention and coverage by The New York Times, The Washington Post, Newsday, Chicago Tribune, International Herald Tribune, The Wall Street Journal, Los Angeles Times and other major media outlets. Her skilled search for the truth about U.S. foreign policy in Venezuela led her to documents obtained through the Freedom of Information Act, and she has discussed her findings during interviews on BBC, CNN, PBS, and Swedish, French and Greek television.

Specializing in immigration and human rights law, Ms. Golinger practices international human rights and immigration law and has also worked with the distinguished International Women’s Human Rights Clinic at CUNY Law School.
