Respect Kampain Spring Tour Releases Other Dates, Locations

A spring tour of Milwaukee schools featuring positive messages and preaching nonviolent strategies to resolve conflicts among teens and young adults has released an updated list of official dates.

The Code of Conduct initiative, supported in part by a street code flyer outlining “rules to live by,” is meant to steer young people toward non-violent conflict resolution and constructive activities, Ald. McGee said. Various community leaders and Hip Hop artists such as Gorilla Promotions, WinMill Records and Trio Recording Artists are joining Ald. McGee as participants in the Street Code All-Stars Tour.

The Respect Kampain Code of Conduct includes several rules or directives to follow, including:

- Adopt an elder (someone who is at least 60 years old)
- Respect each other like you respect your mother
- No shooting and no speeding/swerving
- Get a spiritual sense of purpose
- Turn your music down when you see older people
- No hating, no snitching, no stealing, no lying
- Always protect family & community
