A ribbon cutting and grand opening ceremony is scheduled for tomorrow (**Thursday, September 28, 2006**) for the new luxury Honey Creek Condominiums at N. 73rd and W. Stevenson streets (two blocks south of W. Blue Mound Rd.) The project, on the former site of the Korean Church of Milwaukee, features 32 two- and three-bedroom condominiums in two buildings served by underground parking.

“This new development shows that there continues to be a strong demand for housing in Milwaukee,” said Ald. Michael J. Murphy who represents the area and will join in the ceremony. “The market is showing a definite demand for more condos on the west side, and this development will help satisfy some of that demand.” The alderman also praised CityMark Development for its willingness to work closely with neighbors “to ensure that the development is a complement to the neighborhood.”

Each of the 32 units includes a master bedroom suite, underground, heated parking, gas fireplace, patio or balcony and other quality amenities including a landscaped courtyard. Ten of the units are already occupied and four others are waiting for new owners. The units are priced from \$224,900 to \$289,900.
