Street to be Dedicated for Peacemaker

Tomorrow (Wednesday, November 22, 2006) at 1:00 p.m., Ald. Mike McGee, Jr., will host a street re-naming ceremony for the late **Antoine L. Taylor**, 23, who was gunned down in June when he attempted to break up a fight near his home. The ceremony – to include members of the Taylor family -- will take place at N. 4th and W. Melvina Streets. **Media coverage is invited.**

After Ald. McGee introduced the measure in July, the full Common Council approved the street renaming on November 14. The council has agreed to a moratorium on renaming streets, meaning the Antoine L. Taylor designation could be the last such official action of its kind for some time.

Mr. Taylor's assailant fired into a crowd at the scene of a fight between two women who were arguing over a cell phone in the 3600 block of N. 3rd St. In August the city's Citizen Advisory Committee on Buildings, Facilities and Streets Naming recommended approval of the renaming of N. 4th St. between W. Melvina St. and W. Capitol Pl. in honor of Mr. Taylor.
